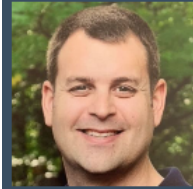

We have blessed to have Tarcisio worshipping with us here at Faith. It has been such a gift to have him as part of our community. Please join us in continuing to pray for him as he returns home




Doug Danckaert

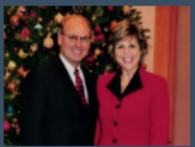
Gloria Pelon

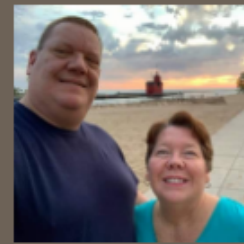


Robert Morgan
