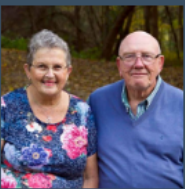
Vern Sterk

Chuck continues to have intense nerve pain on the tops of his feet, all day and into the night. Praying for something that will provide relief from this pain and wisdom in next steps.

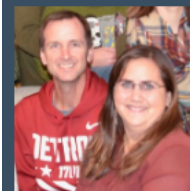


Sam Mulder

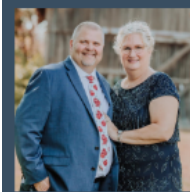


Tim Klunder

Robert continues to recover. His echocardiogram found no heart failure. Praise! He has started physical therapy and is slowly getting a little stronger everyday.

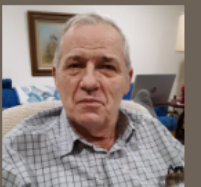


Beth VanDyken
